Please make sure that you complete all the fields at the top of the front of the card.

If you live in the tetrad put L in 'hours spent in tetrad'

Column 1- Possible breeding
 place a tick against each species recorded in breeding season in possible nesting habitat, but with no other indication of breeding

Column 2 - Probable breeding
 S = Singing male present (or breeding calls heard) on more than one date in the same place
 T = Bird (or pair) apparently holding territory
 D = Courtship and display, or agitated behaviour or anxiety calls from adults suggesting probable presence of nest or young nearby; brood patch on trapped female
 N = Visiting probable nest site
 B = Nest building (including excavating nest-hole)

Column 3 - Confirmed breeding
 DD = Distraction display or feigned injury
 UN = Used nest found
 FL = Recently fledged young
 FS = Adult carrying faecal sac
 FY = Adult(s) with food for young
 ON = Adult(s) entering or leaving nest site in circumstances indicating occupied nest
 NE = Nest and eggs, or bird sitting and not disturbed, or eggshells found away from nest
 NY = Nest with young or downy young of ducks, gamebirds, waders etc
